4 OCTOBER 2022 – STAGE 1

The first stage of the 2022-2023 Academic Year Placement and Proficiency Exam will be held face-to-face on campus.

- Students who score 51 or less in the first stage of the exam will continue with the Preparatory Program. These students will be placed into an appropriate level of the Preparatory Program based on the Common European Framework of Reference for Languages (CEFR) according to the results of the first stage exam.
- Students who score 52 and above out of 75 in the first stage of the exam will have the right to participate in the second stage exam.
- Students who do not take the first stage of the exam cannot take the second stage exam. Those students are placed in L1 (Elementary Level) group.
- Students who do not take the second stage exam despite getting sufficient points from the first stage of the exam are placed in the Preparatory Class.
- There is no make-up for the exam.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS

- Students are required to have ID cards (ID card, driving licence, passport, etc.) to be able to take the exam. Without an ID card with the photograph on, it will not be possible for students to take the exam.
- Students are responsible for following the announcements about the exam entirely for the exam venue, time, and rules.
- Students are required to check their classes on YDYO website before the exam and they must be ready in their classes 10 minutes before the start of the exam.
- Students are required to bring their own pencils and erasers to the exam. No sharing of these items will be allowed.
- Students can take the exam if they are in the exam venue in the first 15 minutes, but no additional time will be given to these latecomers.
- Students need to comply with the warnings of the proctors during the session. Therefore, students who do not comply with the specified rules forfeit the right to take the exam.
- Students are not allowed to use extra resources (dictionaries, printed materials, etc.) during the exam session.
- Students are required to provide and check all the necessary information on the exam booklets and optical forms (i.e., names, surnames, school numbers and exam classes).
- Students themselves will be responsible for any errors in the answers (wrong marking of the answer, wrong marking of the student number, missing marking, not finishing or not being able to finish the exam within the specified time, etc.) Thus, they must check the accuracy of the markings before handing in their exam documents. It must be noted that it will not be possible to get back the exam documents after handing them in.
- If it is detected that a student has attempted to cheat in any way, his/her exam score will be cancelled. Additionally, disciplinary and legal actions will be taken for those students.
