PART A: VOCABULARY (10 points)

TASK I-Gap Fill (6 points)

Sample Item:

Complete the sentences with the words from the box. Use each word once. Three words are extra. (6x1=6 points) (0) is an example.

Marking Principle(s):

- **No partial credit.**
- **Spelling mistakes will be ignored.**

TASK II-Word Formation

Sample Test Item

Complete the sentences with the correct form of the word given in parentheses.

(4x1=4 points) (0) is an example.

0. I don't like her brother. He is really UNFRIENDLY. (FRIENDLY)

Marking Principles:

- **No partial credit.**
- **Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake.**



PART B: LANGUAGE USE

TASK I-Text Completion

Sample Test Item

Complete the text with the correct verb form. (8x1=8 points)

I (1) went camping last year. It (2) was very exciting, and I never (3) forget the first day of it because while I (4) was walking in the forest, I (5) saw a bear which (6) was sleeping under the tree. I (7) felt really frightened.

Marking Principles:

- No partial credit.
- Do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies. (e.g. **listenning**)
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake causing grammatical inaccuracies.
- Do not deduct any points for capitalization and punctuation mistakes.
- Mark '0' points if there is a S-V agreement mistake or a mistake in the negation. (e.g. **They goes** to the cinema every weekend. OR **He was** paying attention to the traffic lights when he had an accident.)

TASK II-Restatement

Sample Test Item

Complete the second sentence so that it has a similar meaning to the first sentence. Use the word in parentheses. Do not change the given word. (5x1,5=7,5 points) (0) is an example.

0. The university exam was easier this year than last year's. (MORE)

The university exam was more difficult last year than this year's.

Marking Principles:

- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies. (e.g. **listenning**)
- Mark '0' points if there is a S-V agreement mistake.
- Mark '0' points if the word order is wrong.
- Mark '0' points if there is a problem in the verb tense or in the negation.



TASK III-Error Detection & Correction

Sample Test Item

In each sentence below, there is a mistake. Underline the mistake and write the mistake and its corrected form in the space provided under each sentence. (5x1,5=7,5 points) (0) is an example.

Underlining and writing the mistake: 0,5 pts. Correcting the mistake: 1 pt.

0. Why don't we go for the cinema to watch a film?

Mistake: for / corrected form: to

0. I have seen a very nice film last night.

Mistake: have seen / corrected form: saw

Marking Principles:

- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Ignore spelling mistakes in the mistake part.
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake in the correction part causing any grammatical inaccuracies. However, do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake in the correction which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies. (e.g. **listennning**)

TASK IV-One Word

Sample Test Item

Fill in the gap in each sentence with one word to complete the sentence in a grammatical and meaningful way. (7x1=7 points) (0) is an example.

0. We were going at 90 km/hour when a traffic policeman stopped us.

Marking Principles:

- No partial credit.
- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake.

IMPORTANT REMINDERS:

- Students will take Quiz 2 in the classrooms announced by the administration on **ydyo.kiye.edu.tr** at the specified time presented above.
- Students must be ready in their classes **5 minutes** before the quiz time.



- Students are required to have **ID cards** (ID card, driving license, passport, etc.) to be able to take the exam. Without an ID card with a photograph, it will not be possible for students to take the exam.
- It is the responsibility of students to bring **stationery items** such as pencils, erasers and sharpeners required for the quiz. Students will not be allowed to exchange these materials during the quiz.
- Students **cannot keep papers, notebooks, etc., on their desks** for note-taking purposes.
- Students **are not allowed to use extra resources** (dictionaries, printed materials, etc.) during the exam.
- **Students are required to leave their muted mobile devices on their proctor's desk before the start of each session** in the exam and get them back after submitting their exam papers.
- The quiz is only **one session** consisting of two parts (Vocabulary&Language Use) and there will be no breaks. Students who leave the exam venue cannot be readmitted to continue their exam. Therefore, they must go to the exam venues by making the necessary preparations in advance.
- Students can only leave the quiz session only after handing in their quiz documents.
- Latecomers will be admitted to their classrooms in **the first 10 minutes of the quiz**, but **no additional time** will be provided.
- Accordingly, students **cannot leave** the classrooms **in the first 10 minutes** of the quiz.
- It is the responsibility of students to follow the announcements about the quiz entirely and comply with the warnings of the proctors during the quiz. Therefore, students who do not comply with the specified rules forfeit the right to take the quiz.
- When students start the quiz session, it means they agree that their health condition is suitable for taking the quiz.
- Students will be **responsible for writing their name, surname, school number, and class** correctly.
- The students themselves will be **responsible for any errors** in the answers (wrong marking of the answer, missing marking, not finishing or not being able to finish the quiz within the specified time, etc.) Thus, they must check the accuracy of the marking before handing in their quiz documents. It must be noted that it will not be possible to get back the quiz documents after handing them in.



- Proctors have the right to cancel the quiz of the student(s) on condition that they notice that they are engaged in any suspicious actions during the quiz. If it is detected that **a student has attempted to cheat in any way, a report will be filled out and his/her exam score will be cancelled**. Additionally, **disciplinary and legal actions** will be taken for those students.
- There is **no make-up exam** for Quiz 2.
- Students have the right to **object to their quiz results** only in suspicious cases of miscalculation. Then the student must submit a petition of objection to the SFL Student Affairs Office or send it as an email attachment to ydyo@iyte.edu.tr **within 7 work days** following the announcement of the quiz results.
