## TASK I-Text Completion (8 points)

## Sample Test Item

Complete the text with the verbs in the correct active, passive, gerund or infinitive form. (8x1=8 points)

I (1) *went* (go) camping last year. It (2) *was* (be) very exciting, and I never (3) *forgot* (forget) the first day of it because while (4) *walking* (walk) in the forest, I saw a bear which (5) *was sleeping* (sleep) under the tree. I felt really frightened. Suddenly, a loud noise (6) *was heard / could be heard* (hear) in the distance, and I started running in that direction (7) *to see* (see) what it was although I (8) *had been warned* (warn) earlier by a park ranger to stay away from the area.

## Marking Principles:

- No partial credit.
- Do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies. (e.g. listenning)
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake causing grammatical inaccuracies. (Ex: "has" instead of "had" as in "She **has** three children when she was 25.)
- Do not deduct any points for capitalization and punctuation mistakes.
- Mark '0' points if there is a S-V agreement mistake or a mistake in the negation. (e.g. They **goes** to the cinema every weekend. OR He **was** paying attention to the traffic lights when he had an accident.)

## TASK II-Error Detection &amp; Correction (6 points)

## Sample Test Item

In each sentence below, there is only ONE mistake. Write the mistake and its corrected form in the spaces provided under each sentence. Please note that making the corrections only by adding or omitting "NOT" will not be graded. (4x1,5=6 points)

Writing the mistake: 0,5 pts.      Correcting the mistake: 1 pt.

0. Why don't we go for the cinema to watch a film?

0. I have seen a very nice film last night.

Mistake: have seen / corrected form: saw

## Marking Principles:

- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Ignore spelling mistakes in the mistake part.
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake in the correction part causing any grammatical inaccuracies. However, do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake in the correction which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies. (e.g. listenning)



### TASK III-Restatement (5 points)

#### Sample Test Item

Complete the second sentence in each question with 4-7 words using the words in brackets without changing them. Do NOT change the meaning. (5x1=5 points)

0. The university exam was easier this year than last year's. (MORE)

The university exam was more difficult last year than this year's.

#### Marking Principles:

- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Do not deduct any points if there is a one-letter spelling mistake which does not cause any grammatical inaccuracies (Ex: **listenning**), but mark "0" points if the mistake causes grammatical inaccuracies (Ex: "has" instead of "had" as in "She **has** three children when she was 25.)
- Mark '0' points if there is a S-V agreement mistake. (Ex: They **goes** to the cinema every weekend.)
- Mark '0' points if the word order is wrong (They **go often** to the cinema.).
- Mark '0' points if there is a problem in the verb tense tense (Ex: They **go** the cinema yesterday.) or in the negation (Ex: They **went** to school because it was Sunday.).

### TASK IV-One Word (6 points)

#### Sample Test Item

Fill in the gap in each sentence with ONE word to complete the sentence in a grammatical and meaningful way. Please note that contractions (e.g. isn't) count as one word. (6x1=6 points)

0. We were going at 90 km/hour when a traffic policeman stopped us.

#### Marking Principles:

- No partial credit.
- Do not deduct any points for capitalization & punctuation mistakes.
- Mark '0' points if there is a spelling mistake.

### IMPORTANT REMINDERS:



- Students will take Quiz 4 **in the classrooms announced by the School of Foreign Languages** at the specified time presented above.
- Students must be ready in their classes **5 minutes before** the quiz time.
- Students are required to have **ID cards** (ID card, driving license, passport, etc.) to be able to take the exam. Without an ID card with a photograph, it will not be possible for students to take the exam.
- It is the responsibility of students to bring **stationery items** such as pencils, erasers and sharpeners required for the quiz. Students will not be allowed to exchange these materials during the quiz.
- Students **cannot keep papers, notebooks, etc., on their desks** for note-taking purposes.
- Students **are not allowed to use extra resources** (dictionaries, printed materials, etc.) during the exam.
- **Students are required to leave their muted mobile devices on their proctor's desk before the start of each session** in the exam and get them back after submitting their exam papers. For convenience purposes, students may keep their tablets in their bags.
- **Wearing caps, hats or sunglasses is not allowed during the exam.**
- The quiz is only **one session** consisting of two parts (Vocabulary&Language Use) and there will be no breaks. Students who leave the exam venue cannot be readmitted to continue their exam. Therefore, they must go to the exam venues by making the necessary preparations in advance.
- **Students can only leave the quiz session only after handing in their quiz documents. Those who leave early must immediately leave the buildings where the exam is in progress so as not to disturb their classmates who are still in exam halls.**
- Latecomers will be admitted to their classrooms in **the first 10 minutes of the quiz**, but **no additional time** will be provided.
- Accordingly, students **cannot leave** the classrooms **in the first 10 minutes** of the quiz.
- It is the responsibility of students to follow the announcements about the quiz entirely and comply with the warnings of the proctors during the quiz. Therefore, students who do not comply with the specified rules forfeit the right to take the quiz.
- When students start the quiz session, it means they agree that their health condition is suitable for taking the quiz.



- Students will be **responsible for writing their name, surname, school number, and class** correctly.
- The students themselves will be **responsible for any errors** in the answers (wrong marking of the answer, missing marking, not finishing or not being able to finish the quiz within the specified time, etc.) Thus, they must check the accuracy of the marking before handing in their quiz documents. It must be noted that it will not be possible to get back the quiz documents after handing them in.
- Proctors have the right to cancel the quiz of the student(s) on condition that they notice that students are engaged in any suspicious actions during the quiz. If it is detected that **a student has attempted to cheat** in any way, **a report will be filled out and his/her exam score will be cancelled**. Additionally, **disciplinary and legal actions** will be taken for those students.
- **No other make-up exam** will be administered for Quiz 4.
- Students have the right to **object to their quiz results** only in suspicious cases of miscalculation. Then the student must submit a petition of objection to the SFL Student Affairs Office or send it as an email attachment to [ydyo@iyte.edu.tr](mailto:ydyo@iyte.edu.tr) **within 7 work days** following the announcement of the quiz results.
